

# Three Colorado lawmakers support president

Colorado lawmakers responded to President Bush's stand against Iraq with enthusiastic support Monday night.

Rep. Marilyn Musgrave, a Republican who represents northeastern Colorado's 4th District, along with Colorado Sens.
